Q. How did the course play today? We saw some lower numbers.

CATRIONA MATTHEW: Obviously some people found it a little easier. Yeah, as I said, I just struggled with my putter a little bit. I thought it played fairly similar to yesterday.

Q. What have you learned about the greens so far this week?

CATRIONA MATTHEW: Obviously not enough. But yeah, they're tricky. You've got to try and get it in the right spot. There's a lot of break in some of the putts, so you've got to have your pace right, and I was just a little short on pace today.

I think when the greens are this slopey, it all comes down to the speed.

Q. Sort of a unique finish with the two par-5s. What's your mindset as you navigate the course knowing that's at the end here?



CATRIONA MATTHEW: Yeah, Tsuppose it always gives you that chance. Hopefully they'll play the tees up tomorrow so it gives people a chance to reach the greens and have the chance at eagle. But you know they're not gimme birdies even though they're reachable.

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
