I had been playing the front nine really well, and this is probably the worst I've played the front nine all week, and combined with him shooting 5-, 6-under, whatever he did, it just was not a good matchup, so I was in a pretty big hole. Tried not to lose any confidence or any hope and tried to grind it out and put some pressure on him, but there just weren't enough holes left.

Q. I know the competition season is coming to a close, but do you have any big events coming up after this?

CHRISTIAN CAVALIERE: Almost done here. I think I have one or two back in New York and then I'm playing the Carey Cup which is like the MGA against Ireland, so we'll play that over in Portmarnock in Ireland. I think that's it. It's been a long season. I need to go hibernate for the winter and take a break.
