

GABRIELA RUFFELS: It was awesome, first British Open and first time in Europe. First time playing golf in Europe, and the conditions this week were not easy. So I mean, I was paired with some really awesome players, Angela Stanford and Catriona Matthews. So it was awesome to learn from them, too, and draw from their experience. Such a fun week.

GABRIELA RUFFELS: For sure. I think I can just draw a lot of confidence from this. I played the U.S. Open last year. That was my first major and I wasn't kind of near the cut. I think I was kind of intimidated by the players and



seeing everyone that I kind of watch on TV but I think that I'm closer than what I think and I think that's something I can learn and draw from this week for sure.
