Q. Fantastic day, what a way to end the Trust Golf Women's Scottish Open. How are you feeling after the final round?

I think with that mindset, putts a lot less pressure on it and I'm out there just playing golf and not trying to do -- like trying to get extra out of something that I can't control.

Q. Last two rounds bogey-free has to help your confidence heading into the major?

LYDIA KO: Yeah, I think overall having a good finish here, hopefully that gives me good momentum into next week. This was great golf course leading up to Carnoustie. This is a true links, and obviously we know what Carnoustie is like.
