EONIE HARM: Thank you very much. I really enjoyed another welcoming Scottish day. Barely even noticeable we are in Scotland at all. Conditions wonderful. Golf course is in great shape and the water we got yesterday softened the greens, and you could attack the flags and it was quite fun.

I had one chip up-and-down which that rarely happens and I'm just glad I could seep the card clean again and I'm intending to continue to do so through rougher conditions on the weekend.

Q. Absolutely and I saw you went for the last in two, that can be scary, water around, clearly that doesn't seem to phase you?

LEONIE HARM: My caddie, we stood there and it was an inconvenient number because 3-wood was going to be too much and hybrid was going to be too short and he was like, you know, what I don't see it and I was like, you know what, I don't see a pitch either.

I intended to go to that back bunker and ended up just short of that and gave me a bit of a tricky chip shot. Gave the putt a good chance but it was a bit short. Happens but my lay up would have been a 9-iron and, I don't know that kind of felt wrong. Yeah, sees the moment.

Q. Wonderful field, one of best we've ever had at this golf tournament and you're in the mix going into the weekend. What expectations are you putting on yourself heading into the weekend?

LEONIE HARM: Well, expectations are always a tricky thing in golf because no two days are ever alike. I have some goals to basically stay in the moment and hit one shot at a time because links golf can be brutal at times and you just have to not get ahead of yourself is probably the



mentality you want to do, and just enjoying another 36 holes out there.

Yeah, I mean, there's nothing really more to say, like obviously it's a great honor to compete with some of the best players in the world and that's what we are doing this for, right.

Q. If you post another couple of bogey-free rounds, you've genuinely got a chance, haven't you?

LEONIE HARM: I think everyone has a chance eventually, right. Yeah, there's a lot of things that have to come together for an actual win but even if I could just find myself in who know, top 10, top 20 in this tournament after the week, I'll be proud and happy to head into another links test next week and I'm super excited for this stretch.

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
