GEORGIA HALL: Yeah, exactly, it's gone quite quickly when you get in tournament mode. Definitely going to have a lie in the next couple days because the early starts takes it out of you, but really enjoying being back on tour.

Q. How satisfied are you with today's round and the last three days knowing that you've moved yourself up the leaderboard?

GEORGIA HALL: Yeah, hopefully top 10, if not very close, so...

I think I got similar to that last time I was at this course so I



like it quite a bit. It's just getting a lot of confidence into the following week.
