I like it when it's tough, and I like it when you have to think. I'm very happy with how the week went.

GABY LOPEZ: It's amazing. I mean, seeing so many kid around, you never know who is going to be the next Nasa or next Se Ri Pak. So yeah, it's super inspiring, and this is exactly why the sport goes the way it goes; it's because of fans and because of the young kids. I was
