Finally at the last round I kind of had my head around again, like thinking more smart, more of the -- you know, more of the strategy over the technique.

And I think that kind of tried to carry over to here. I mean, the green is narrow, but like the fairway is wide, so you have lots of chance hitting off the fairway so that makes it a little bit easier.

# Q. Uh-huh. So when you woke up this morning when you were practicing, were you feeling this good about your game today?

XIYU LIN: I always know on this course you can go low and you probably have to go low in this tournament, so I just keep telling myself, you know, when I have an opportunity I need to go for it.

And then especially the par-5s, they're all really like



attackable, and then you have to be really aggressive on it. I'm pretty happy like the whole -- like it go by plan.
