

But it's exciting for tomorrow, but you just got to do what you normally do and see what it brings out for tomorrow.

Q. What will be your approach for tomorrow then?

NANNA KOERSTZ MADSEN: Stay patient. You got to



make a lot of the birdies but you can't force them. Then you won't make any.

You just got to stay patient and see if the putt drops.

Q. This final question, what would it mean to you to win the Honda LPGA Thailand this year?

NANNA KOERSTZ MADSEN: It would be amazing winning a first LPGA event. That's what I play for, so that would be just awesome.
