Q. When you played, what was sort of your experience and what kind of advice might you give Lexi?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: I was super lucky, so it was one of my sponsors for the one that I did, the Barbasol. I'm not sure how she got invited to this one. It's Lexi Thompson.
