Q. We were just talking before we got on camera here about you being 72nd on the CME points list. Is that something that plays on your mind heavily playing the last few events?

SARAH KEMP: It's all I'm thinking about, to be honest with you. I'm in a really nice position this year. I've pretty much locked up my card and I'm fighting for CME.
