GEORGIA OBOH: I didn't really kind of pay attention to how many birdies we'd made on the front nine, but really we were just trying to take it one hole at a time, one shot at a time, and just really focus. There was a bunch of wind, and the greens were rolling really well. We knew if we got close, we could make a lot of birdies.

LAKAREBER ABE: Yeah, I won't lie, I'm a peeker, so I kind of knew. I knew people were making a lot of birdies, so I was just like, let's try and make one more, let's try and make one more. There were some gettable pins on the front nine, so you could be a little bit more aggressive. But it's really easy -- it's not super easy, but it's nice when you have a partner like Georgia.

Shippen event, talk about how thankful you are for that opportunity and just the experience from both of you this week to being a Dow ambassador.

GEORGIA OBOH: Yeah, winning the John Shippen was really big for me this summer. I had a lot of things lined up, and knowing that I was going to play two LPGA events was really special, and then coming here I'd never been to Midland before, and I didn't really know what to expect, but it's been such a great week.
