Q. Birdies today at 8, 9, 11, and 13.

SARAH KEMP: Uh-huh.

Q. Any of those stand out on the day to help give you some good vibes in the tournament?

SARAH KEMP: Yeah, the mojo really kicked in on 8. I want to say that was like 40 feet. Hit it in the right bunker and hit a 7-iron out to about 40 feet and made that.

It kind of kicked me back into gear. Went for it in two on 9 and hit a chip shot to about -- 30-yard chip shot to maybe 15 feet and holed that.

9 was a 9-iron to about six feet.

So just, yeah, solid and just didn't have a bogey.

Q. No, I mean, after 8 -- or after 7.

SARAH KEMP: Oh, yeah, just the one on -- yeah, that's right.

Q. Just the one on 6.

SARAH KEMP: Yep, and I holed another bomb on 13. I want to say that was, oh, gosh, maybe like another 35-footer. Couple bombs today really helped.

Q. Do you to you like the tournament, the format, same courses, venue, prize winnings?

SARAH KEMP: I love it. I wish we could do more of it. Obviously never missed a Vic Open when it's been co-sanctioned with the guys. It's just fun. Like I love -- I follow them all the time. I follow the Australian boys and got to see them on the range this week.

Yeah, it's a lot of fun. I hope we can do more of it?

SARAH KEMP: It's really solid. I'm just putting great. Like I holed some really good momentum par saves this week, obviously some long birdie putts. But that's kind of been the difference this year. Just some few extra putts dropping.
