HAE RAN RYU: It hasn't been that long ago since I was a rookie on the KLPGA, so to be a rookie once again feels new. Like I said, it hasn't been that long since I've been a rookie on KLPGA, and I look forward to playing on the LPGA next year.



Q. How do you think the experience on the KLPGA helped you this week and will help you next year?

HAE RAN RYU: A lot of the Korean golf courses are very narrow compared to the ones here in the U.S. which means my shots need to be very accurate, and that helped me a lot to play this week.

Q. Finally, how proud are you of yourself and this accomplishment? It's a big one.

HAE RAN RYU: There wasn't a lot of stroke difference when I first started this morning so I felt a little nervous, but overall I feel like I've grown once again by playing the O-Series.
