So mentally we knew what to expect. We weren't going to let our ego get the best of us and try to muscle a club because we should hit it a certain number.


We were just really mentally prepared for the ball not flying as far, and our layers and hand warmers did the rest of the work.


# Q. What does that mean coming at the end of the season getting that bill fronted for you heading into this week?


