RUIXIN LIU: I feel like all the Asia courses are very hilly, but like Shanghai was perfect whether and Korea was extremely cold and this week is extremely hot. I think just mentally we need to be prepared, and so far I don't have any high expectation. I think that helps a lot, yeah.

Q. You're top 20 in round one scoring average on the LPGA Tour. What do you like so much about the start of tournaments?

RUIXIN LIU: No pressure. There is no cut this week so just trying to enjoy my time with John out there and trying to have a great time.

Q. It would be remiss of me not to touch upon your golf swing. It's something we've spoke about in commentary.

RUIXIN LIU: I know.

Q. It is unique, but it's also very solid, very repeatable. How did it all come about?

RUIXIN LIU: When I played junior golf I was quite small in my group. The only way for me to catch up distance-wise was I have to turn a lot. I just get used to it. I can't really



see my golf ball on the way back and that's something people always talk about, and I'm quite enjoying it actually.
