Yeah, overall very pleased with how it went.

Q. You've had a really awesome last few stretches; another top 10 finish here. Talk about the golf you're playing. You kind of fly under the radar it seems like a little bit.

HANNAH GREEN: Yeah, I definitely feel like that this week. I remember last year I got off to a really good start and then kind of fell off, so it's nice to have the opposite this week.

Obviously the win last week and then a nice 7-under is



really good. I actually have a couple weeks off now. I'm not going to Japan.
