I would say probably a little tighter than what I'm used to off the tee, so making sure I'm hitting the fairways, especially with the thick rough.

SAVANNAH GREWAL: Just hanging out in Clemson, South Carolina playing some golf, hanging out with former teammates, just living life really.

Q. And then your caddie this week, you want talk about that?

He played in the word championships for table tennis two weeks ago, flew home for five days, and then flew straight here to caddie for me, and then he is going to fly home and go to the Olympic qualifiers for table tennis.
