

You got really, really slopey greens and you can get yourself in trouble even on the green, so being on the right side of the green and trying to attack the par-5s when you have a chance. They're gettable. You got to be patient on par-3s. They can get a little tough, especially into the wind.

Yeah, I think being aggressive when you can and be patient when you have to.

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
