You're not hitting a lot of club into some holes and some of the pins are favorable with the slope, so you got to take advantage of that, and you got to hit some good shots. It's easy to kind of say that the course is easy, but you still got to do it. Yeah, looking forward to getting going on the weekend.

Q. How much does experience or course knowledge or whatever you want to call it, how much does that help on this course?

MATT FITZPATRICK: A little bit. I don't think it's massive compared to some other golf courses. I think I feel like it's a fairly generous golf course off the tee. I think maybe a little bit of knowledge on the greens about the grains, but other than that not much.

about how the course played?
