#### Q. How would you characterize your round today?

PATRICK CANTLAY: Gap wedge.

# Q. Forecast is for blowing 22 tomorrow, with gusts to 30. What's the most important thing you have to do tomorrow?

PATRICK CANTLAY: I think just stay patient and hit solid shots. In the wind it's really important to hit it solid and keep you wits about you.

# Q. Was it a situation where this just didn't fit where it was? This being your first time here, did you watch it and figure you would play here one day?

PATRICK CANTLAY: Yeah, I think I just usually play a heavy West Coast and this is right after the West Coast. And in the past I've taken a couple weeks off.
