Q. Just finished the round. We'll talk about the belt in a minute. First off, just talk about the experience, the week being back together and basically playing father/son round for three days?

I got out to a good start on day one and had to hold onto it from there. I think with me getting the belt this year, I think everybody's had the belt -- each different group has the belt the last couple of years. Pops had it first.
