- 1. Event Name which is typically the name of the event or organization.
- 2. Date of transcript. The format of the date can be modified as requested.
- 3. City State and Country.
- 4. The name of the team the speakers are a part.
- 5. The Venue of the event.
- 6. Speaker Name
- 7. A Description or Title of the the Speaker
- 8. The Interview type which can further describe the event.
- 9. Optional extra information or description.

As a reminder not of the items need be used and the default order, size style can be adjusted.





To the right of the header is the logo whose proportion is 950x250 pixels.

As mentioned, below the header begins the body of the text. The default is to have the Questions as bold and the Speaker Name as plain. Other options to make all text plain or have the Speaker Name as bold are available.

And being the Jack Nicklaus tournament, I always look up to him as a player and as a-- as a man, how he is. And just an honor. And I'm just really happy and I'm going to try to really enjoy this week.

Q. Just wondering if you could talk for a minute about any influence that Lorena Ochoa has had on your career or your golf or any connection with her.

CARLOS ORTIZ: She's really been a really big influence on my career. We are from the same country club. So I grew up with her.

When I was young, starting to play golf, she was a sensation. And just being able to see how somebody can make their dreams come true with the hard work. Because I saw how hard she worked and dedication. And so being able to see that from close, it's really an inspiration.
