Q. Career-low 62. Take us through it.

I'm trying to play as much as I can, trying to enjoy it, trying to embrace it, and trying to improve my status for next year. That's all I'm trying to do.

Q. A lot of guys are after that carrot that's out there that would get you into the Signature Events. Have you thought much about that or are you just trying to improve weekly?

LUDVIG ABERG: Obviously it's a goal, but all I can do is



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try to do what I did today. If I can do that multiple times, I'll see where I end up.

Obviously everyone wants to get in there. Everyone wants to play the big tournaments. Same for me.

That's what it is, and all I try to do is prepare as good as I can for every event and then go out and play and have fun.
