Q. Playing in the final group today. What are your thoughts on the week?

C.T. PAN: It's still a very good week considering I switched at three hotels first. I did not sleep well the first couple nights. But considering that, I still played great out there. I was able to recover a lot of my, get a lot of good sleep starting on Wednesday. So pretty happy with that. Final grouping was probably my first time on Sundays. So it was my first experience.
