THE MODERATOR: Sorry for the defeat. How much did the lack of matches affect you in your performance today?

ALISON van UYTVANCK: Yeah, I think it always is a component you don't want to have. You want to have as much more matches you can have under your belt. Of course I only had two after Wimbledon with the back issues I'm having, or had. The back is fine now.

I believe we can still do it. I feel that with Elise and Flipper, we have a good experienced doubles, as well.
