THE MODERATOR: Questions, please.

Q. Can you talk about your next match, please? Your thoughts going into the next round?

SLOANE STEPHENS: Obviously, I play the winner of the match that's still playing now. It will be a good match against whoever opponent I play, whichever opponent I



play.

Q. Is it the kind of thing your coach scouts, or you have been around long enough to know how they play?

SLOANE STEPHENS: Obviously, familiar with both of their games, but I'm sure my coach will watch and see what's going on.

Obviously, at altitude everybody plays a little bit different, so it will be good to get out there and see what's going on. Obviously, they are playing a good match. So it will be interesting to see what they're both doing.
