ARYNA SABALENKA: I felt like I had a lot of time. I had a lot of options what to do with that ball. I was overthinking, overdoing stuff. I was kind of like pissed with myself that I couldn't stick to the simple stuff.

Yeah, that was a bit fun at the beginning. I'm glad that, yeah, I closed this match in two sets.

Q. You have a good record here, in Australia. Possibly last time you were on that court things didn't go quite so well. Is that a way to exorcize demons?

ARYNA SABALENKA: Well, I didn't think about that last



match. Elena just played incredible tennis. She just smashed everything. It seemed that day that whatever she would do, it would go in. Whatever I would try to do, it would be completely off.

That was just the perfect game from Elena and terrible job from my team. Whatever, blame someone, right? That's the key (smiling).

Yeah, I'm glad that I came back, got the win. Kind of like on the new road.

Q. Does it feel like this is a great way to start the season, going for a third straight Australian Open?
