The idea of the Laver Cup, of course its history, rivals becoming teammates as well. Just the experience as a fan, what you get. How they deck out the entire arena. When you show up from the first moment till the last, you want the experience to be one that's fantastic. You actually wish that the Laver Cup was for a longer period of time or more often during the year.

Actually you almost miss it when it's already over because it's only three days, high intensity, and you see obviously the world's greatest players playing against each other, then also being on teams.
