SEAMUS POWER: For me I'm going to try to do more of the same. I actually was very pleased on the back nine. Hit some better shots than I've been hitting. I look the greens. Putter has been rolling well so hopefully more of the same on the weekend.

SHANE LOWRY: I was disappointed coming down the last few holes. Just felt like I couldn't get anything going but I felt that today and on the back nine felt like I found





something in my putting and my game that I was not happy missing the cut but I would have been happier leaving here today because I felt like I found something. I'm optimistic for the weekend. I know I need to go shoot two low scores to have a good week. Playing with Seamus, he's playing tied fourth or fifth and he's only five ahead of me. If I can put a low one in the morning, you never really.

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
