MATT FITZPATRICK: I had a great three-ball, me, Viktor and Edoardo. Felt very relaxed the first two days which was nice. Had a good two days.

Q. Minus eight, how is your game?

MATT FITZPATRICK: Up-and-down, plenty of birdies but plenty of bogeys, too. Obviously pleased with the start I made this morning. But going into the weekend, position I'm in, I'm very happy.

Q. What do you think about The Ryder Cup course?

MATT FITZPATRICK: Yeah, it's going to be great. The holes are set up for crowds to be surrounded. The viewing is pretty good. I'm sure the atmosphere is going to be
