Q. As you're heading to 17 down one, what were you thinking?

ANEKA SEUMANUTAFATA: I didn't really think about it, to be honest. I kind of just stuck to what I know best, just stick with my game plan. Coming into 17, hitting that shot, kind of moved the chains for me coming into 18. That approach shot also got me momentum into the last putt.

Q. How far out were you on the approach there on 18?

ANEKA SEUMANUTAFATA: 191, playing 200, so I hit a 4-iron up there.

Q. Heck of a shot, and you put it to --

ANEKA SEUMANUTAFATA: Like six feet.
