Q. Anything unique to your approach, how you approach this golf course?

MEGHA GANNE: I mean, I think it's really wide off the tee and like when it is like that, it's easy to get -- not narrow in on focus starting from the beginning of the hole.

So I think making sure you find that extra bit of focus, because you really can hit it anywhere off the tee has been important.

And honestly, enjoying the views and the walks. This is



probably one of my favorite golf courses I've ever played.
