

CAMERON YOUNG: I got off to a really nice start, then had no idea where the ball was going to go for about 12 holes. Then birdied on 17 and lost by two.

Q. What did you see in Bob's round that was impressive?

CAMERON YOUNG: He came back really well. I don't know, he's a good golfer, and he got off to a bad start and



finished really well.

Q. Something in his game that you think is particularly impressive?

CAMERON YOUNG: I don't really feel like talking about it, to be honest.
