Q. By being in the semifinals you get exempt for two years, but the college guys don't always end up using the exemptions, but it's got to be a great day, huh?

PALMER JACKSON: It is.

Q. Is this your best effort, best run in a championship? You made it to the quarters?

PALMER JACKSON: I made it to the guarters, Davis the round of 16. But first semifinal. There's still eight people left.

Q. There's no more USGA champions left. You're going to get two Florida teens tomorrow.

PALMER JACKSON: Exactly.
