Just pulled both of those. I'll go and work on that, maybe mental work more than technical work.

Yeah, if it I can mix it up tomorrow and make a few birdies on the front nine, who knows. I'm just happy to be in this position through 54 holes.

**Q. Currently five shots back of Louis. What do you need to do tomorrow to try and...**

DYLAN FRITTELLI: I guess more so what Louis needs to do. Slow down and make a few bogeys. I'm not going to wish that on him obviously, but, no, he's going to take some catching in the form he's in right now. Three-under through the front nine would be a good goal. And from there, who knows what happens of if I make a few putts. Never know what can happen.
