RICHARD TEDER: I knew I can't really beat Bryson DeChambeau in a long drive contest, but I thought it was going to be close. I thought I was going to lose by 10, 15 yards. It was close really, but it was loads of fun.

RICHARD TEDER: He's my favourite player. I got asked in an interview before I came here what would be my dream pretty
