Q. Sum up your day today.

But I kind of said, like a 3-wood's got no chance of getting there, so I got to take the next club up which a driver and just kind of went for it.

Q. To win it over the last puts another point on the board, how much confidence does that give you going into tomorrow?

ANNABELL FULLER: I think it's really important to kind of start strong and kind of, I think, it looks like we'll be two points up, maybe three, hopefully, or like two and a half again, which I think is really important going into tomorrow knowing that we dominated in both foursomes and four-ball.
