LAUREN WALSH: Yeah, Louise played great yesterday and looks like she's doing okay out there again today. It's a lot of fun. After yesterday I was hoping to try and make the cut, and just coming into the week I was looking to gain some experience of like what this atmosphere is like, and yeah, excited to be here.

THE MODERATOR: What's it been like being around top professionals in this type of environment?

LAUREN WALSH: Yeah, it's definitely been an incredible experience. Hopefully this is something that I'll do in the future, and yeah, it's just exciting to be part of it now as an amateur and gain that bit of experience moving forward.
