But, yeah, pretty hard to hit it hard.

**Q. How much do you enjoy the links and these conditions?**

JENNY SHIN: Yeah, I love playing the links, and this is a proper links golf course. So yeah, it's a lot of fun. Makes you think. My head hurts right now because so much thinking going on. I love golf courses where it's not just straightforward. Just hit driver, hit second shots. It's like where do we place the driver, where do we place the second shot. Everything is about placement, so really fun.

**Q. 3-under; a player is 11 right now. Do you think there is a chance to go for it tomorrow?**

JENNY SHIN: Yeah, we'll see. The weather is supposed to be pretty horrendous. I'm quite happy I put myself up there. I think the rain is supposed to come in the morning

and I kind of wanted to avoid the morning tee times.
