**Q. Ashley, thank you so much for joining us. Three rounds done here at the Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific. You're in a nice position on the leaderboard. How are you feeling?**

ASHLEY LAU: Honestly, I'm really not thinking much about the leaderboard, just trying to play my game out there and enjoy my golf as much as possible.

**Q. Talking of your game, can you talk to us about your round today?**

ASHLEY LAU: Yeah, three birdies on the front nine, which got me going a little bit. Then a bogey on 10 which got me a little frustrated. Not frustrated, but a little, I would say -- it was just the smallest mistake where I was, okay, just be patient and birdies will come. And it came on 16 and 18.

**Q. The little mistake out there, what was that?**

ASHLEY LAU: I would say commitment. I didn't commit to my shot. That was, I think, about 40 metres from the pin. I didn't commit to it, and I kind of thinned it a little and went over the green, and I made bogey from there.

**Q. So a birdie to finish up the last?**

ASHLEY LAU: Yes.

**Q. Must be very happy to take that momentum into tomorrow?**

ASHLEY LAU: Yeah, very happy. I'm just trying to keep the same game plan for tomorrow as the last three days.

**Q. Talk to us about the birdie on 18.**

ASHLEY LAU: I had my drive off the lower right into the rough and then went for it. Ended up in the bunker. Hit it to about 12, 15 feet, and I made the putt.
