Q. Sophie, great round today in tough conditions; shot 3-under. Talk us through your round. Nice way to finish at the end with a birdie.

SOPHIE HAN: Yeah, so today's round I putted really, really well. I feel like what I did yesterday really helped me a lot in the tough condition. I know you're not going to hit a lot of good shots out there, make it really close, so I just do my best to putt it as close as I can.

So I make a lot of good putts out there. I had one, I feel, really impressive shot on hole 3 or hole 4, the Par-5. I have 200 yards left, downwind, so I hit my 20 degrees and a little bit catch -- have really lucky bounce from the left and kick it to the right.

So that gives me a chance for eagle, but I missed it, but it was really good shot from there.

Also have a really good putt. I have a few really good putts on the back nine and front nine. Also finish with a birdie is really, really good today, yeah.

Q. Sounds like you can be a little bit aggressive on this course heading into the weekend.

SOPHIE HAN: Yeah, of course. My game plan is always really aggressive. Just depends how good that day I feel. Really I will try my best to stay really focused on the weekend. It's a really tough course and you can be -- the wind affects a lot. Sometimes when wind picks up a lot it makes the whole course difficult, so you have to always be patient out there and have to concentrate on each and every shot. Just try to play smart.

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
