Q. Describe your emotions now that you're through to the last day.

Q. Do you allow yourself to start thinking of the big prize yet or are you very much focused on your process?

VEIKKA VISKARI: I think it's always in the back of the head, but I'll just take it one shot at a time and one game at a time.

Q. How do you reset and readjust for another big day tomorrow?

VEIKKA VISKARI: We're just going to go have dinner and take it easy tonight and then get back here tomorrow and take it from there.

Q. You mentioned the course is playing firmer and the wind got up a little bit today. Did you have to adjust your game plan?

VEIKKA VISKARI: No, not really. I think this is a place



where it gets you a long way if you just keep it on the right side and hit it to 20 feet a lot, and just make a couple of those, and there you go, you've got 69 or 68 on the card.

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
