CHRIS WILLIS: Yeah, it was really good. I did not adapt well to start. I had a double-bogey on 77 yards and then I took a bogey on a par 5, both because I misjudged the conditions and after that, I adjusted quite well and made sure I kept track of the wind and accounted for the softer conditions today.

### Q. Because you're currently in third place, do you think you can be flying the flag for Canada tomorrow?

CHRIS WILLIS: I hope so. I think I've got a special round in me tomorrow.
