Q. Highlights of the day?

BRENDAN LAWLOR: You don't want to see anyone not play because of an injury like that. He's an extremely good competitor. The last two years we've had a serious battle. It went right down to the last both years. Not seeing him here is a shame.

But there are a lot of good players out there that could go well this week. It's not my main focus. I'm just going to focus on myself and keep doing what I'm doing.

Q. How nice is it to be back again?

BRENDAN LAWLOR: It's unreal. It's a shame we won't be back here for a fourth year. I think it's moving somewhere



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else. But just the hospitality, the people, the volunteers, I want to thank them all, as well for doing such a great job.
