THE MODERATOR: Questions in English, please.

Q. Marcelo, I wanted to know what are some of the things you've learned from playing with Julien over the





last two years? Because I think there's maybe 10 years separating you two in terms of experience on the tour. So what have you really learned in the time that you've been together?

MARCELO AREVALO: Well, as I said, I'm really open to learn new things all the time. And I learn a lot from all my partners.

And, of course, I learn a lot of things from Jules. He's a super hard worker guy. Always does whatever it takes to be ready for practice, for matches, for tournaments. And that's something that I really appreciate that I learned from him.

You know, like, no matter what the situation, no matter if we're going through good moments or bad moments tennis-wise, you know, you've got to stick to your routines, to your beliefs, and keep working for those goals.
