Q. With D.C. and now here you've had quite a few long matches these last past couple of weeks. Physically how are you feeling? How is the body holding up? You've got a busy few weeks ahead as well. Generally, how are you feeling?

ELENA RYBAKINA: Well, of course, a little bit getting tired of my issues, but we're managing. Overall I'm happy that I'm ready to play these long matches. I think it's a good



preparation for US Open in the end of the day. It's only going (indiscernible) for me.

Q. You'll face Marta Kostyuk in the quarterfinals. Talk us through how you'll approach that, experience playing her in the past, and what you feel you have to do really well to win that.

ELENA RYBAKINA: We played a couple of times. So different surface, but it's always tough battle. There is noisy matches, that's for sure.

I will try to focus on myself. I know that she's really fighter, and she's really physically tough opponent. So yeah, I will try to do my best and hopefully can win that match.
