

WYATT OMSBERG: Just put this one behind us. Tough night overall like I said. We need to think back. Just a couple weeks ago, we were in a really good form. Before the Leagues Cup, we had won a lot of games in a row and we won a couple games away in a lot of tough places to play. I think we know that we have the capability to play with anybody in the League and I think we just need to start showing it again because it's a critical point in the season and Saturday is a big one for us. We'll just turn the page, put it behind us and get ready for Saturday.

Q. Despite the poor recent results, still a lot of Chicago fans in the crowd. How nice for the players to have them up there and how much of a motivational





factor will it be going forward knowing that you still have the support of these fans?

WYATT OMSBERG: Yeah, it was huge. Like I said, it's a tough place to play, and we had a good number in that session. We really appreciate it. It's a Wednesday night and we had a lot of people show up. Disappointing to not give them a better performance tonight.

But yeah, we'll try and make things right on Saturday. Our fans have been there through thick and thin. It's obviously been a little bit more difficult but we're hoping to turn things around starting Saturday, a huge game for us for sure.
