STEPHANIE KYRIACOU: So I had a Yes putter, which not many people would know because they don't really make them anymore. And I now have a Scotty Cameron Newport.

THE MODERATOR: Did you start that this week?

STEPHANIE KYRIACOU: Yeah, yeah. So I just practiced with it a little bit last week and this was the first tournament week or first tournament I had with a different putter in a while, so a little bit nerve wracking but, yeah, settled in easily.

THE MODERATOR: A four-hour delay means you got to somehow keep yourself, your mindset still there. What did you do during the delay and when did you decide to go



back out and practice, maybe hit a couple balls before going out?

STEPHANIE KYRIACOU: Well, I think I did what everyone did, which was try to dry the clubs and clothes as much as we could before we went back out. The rest of the time I just hung out with some of the girls, some of the Aussie girls and talked a bit of crap, which we always do. So it's nothing new. And then I probably started warming up about 40 minutes before we actually had to go out, just a few balls, few putts.
