It's fine.

Q. Still a solid round to round off the week, and a solid finish here in Scotland. How do you assess the week as a whole?

MAJA STARK: A lot of good things. Felt like I managed to keep it easier and managed to strike the ball well, finally my irons back and my putting was pretty solid. So yeah, lots of good things, and then obviously just getting more patient would be the thing, and just accepting the bad lies
